

PENNSYLVANIA VOTING REQUIREMENTS: Any U.S. citizen may vote who is at least 18 years of age, has lived in Pennsylvania for at least 30 days, and has up-to-date registration. Individuals qualified to vote in Pennsylvania who have moved to another Pennsylvania district less than 30 days before an election may vote in their former district.

VOTER REGISTRATION: PA residents can register to vote online at www.votespa.com, or in person at PA driver's license centers. Mail-in registration forms are also available at libraries, public schools, state colleges, PA DOT, offices of Depts. of Aging, Revenue, Public Assistance and PA Game, Unemployment Comp. Offices, post offices and liquor stores. College students living in PA may register at their college address. To vote for candidates in the primary, you must register by political party; if you do not designate a party, you may vote in the primary only on ballot questions. You may change your party affiliation any time during the registration period by completing the mail-in registration form.

POLLING PLACES: You vote in the district in which you are registered. Locations of polling places are listed in your local newspaper before each election, at www.votespa.com, and at vote411.org.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: Absentee ballots may be used by persons who know in advance that they will be unable to get to their designated polling place on the date of election. The process has two steps; application for the absentee ballot and voting by absentee ballot. Application forms may be requested by phone from the County Election Board. After processing your application, the Election Board will mail you your absentee ballot. Ballots are due back at the Election Board prior to the election date (see Election Calendar on cover).
